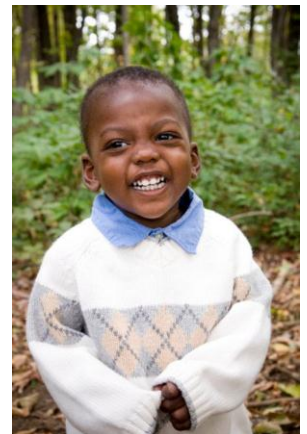


While you often asked us to provide more paperwork than others were requesting, on many occasions this information showed itself to be of significant and utmost importance in helping to move our adoption process further ahead.
